

## FAQ ON "START SCHOLARSHIPS"

### **Do I have to apply for admission to the degree programme and the scholarship application together?**

Two separate applications are required:

Please note that the enrolment for applicants of the Viadrina Intensive Track and the Study Bridge works via the project coordination of the Viadrina College. A separate application via the above-mentioned link is not necessary.

### **Who is NOT eligible to apply? (Information on eligibility are given in the tender offer)**

Students who

- are only studying at the EUV for one or two semesters as a guest student
- have previously studied at another German higher education institution
- submit their application after the deadline

### **Which documents do I have to submit for the scholarship?**

The completed online application form and a letter of motivation of at least half a page.

### **Where do I need to send the application documents?**

The application documents need to be uploaded online via the application portal.

### **How will I know if I receive the scholarship?**

You will receive written information, which we will be send by mail in mid-October to the address given in the application. Please make sure that the address is correct and complete.

### **Can I receive another scholarship at the same time as the start-up scholarship?**

No. Parallel funding with another scholarship is not possible.

### **How and when will the selection be made?**

A ranking forms according to the Abitur grade or the grade of the University Entrance Examination (HZP), taking into account your letter of motivation.

### **Who makes the decision?**

The decision is made by the selection committee.

**How and when will the scholarship be paid off?**

The money will be transferred to your bank account in Germany or Poland. For this purpose, we need your bank details in October. In exceptional cases, a cash payment is possible. The first transfer will be made on 15.11.

**Will I get the registration fee back?**

Yes. If the full amount has been paid, please contact the Enrolment Office as soon as you have received the notification of award.

**Can I lose my entitlement to the scholarship?**

Yes, in the case of incorrect information in the application, exmatriculation, leave of absence or change of university as well as double funding.
